CUSTOMER OBLIGATIONS

- Customers need to seek prior approval from BOMAG (GB) Ltd before commencing work
- ✓ All parts must be ordered in one consolidated order as stock order
- ✓ Where lubricants are used these must be BOMAG Genuine Lubricants
- Additional discounts is paid for in form of credit notes after completion of the refurbishment work
- Customers must provide before and after documentation



CUSTOMER OBLIGATIONS

Where customers carry out refurbishments BOMAG (Great Britain) Ltd requires the following documentation:

- Before and after photos of:
 - Machine serial number
 - Entire machine
 - ✓ Components to be replaced under the refurbishment programme
- Order / Invoice Number for parts used
